Better tracking of who has seen the document before being submitted to UCC. We will ask what groups have already seen the proposal. We will also ask for recommendations of other groups that should review the document.

At what point should we receive a proposal? They should be submitted after the campus group (i.e., Senate, Council, administrative unit, etc.) has approved it.

Should submission of policy proposals be mandatory? The President and Provost would have to insist that submission to UCC has been done before they approve the policy.

If the UCC Chair receives information with a proposal that the document has been widely reviewed before submission to UCC, he may decide to expedite the document without the 30 day review. The UCC members would be notified that the document has been expedited.
