Bedrock streams:

*bed rock - A general term for the rock, usually solid, that underlies the soil or other unconsolidated material

Alluvial Streams:

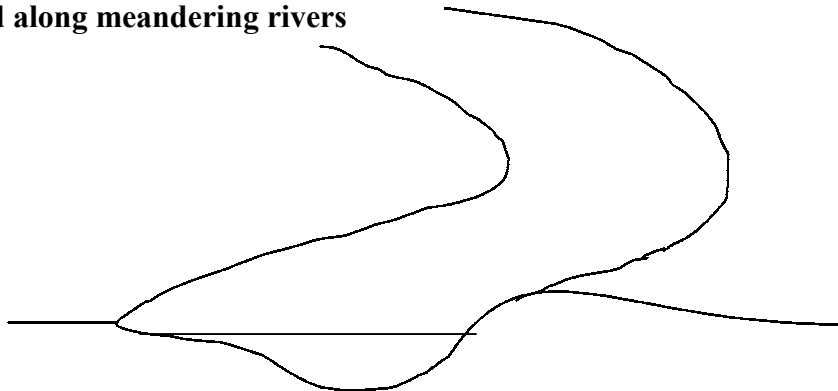
Braided Stream – an anastomosing network of shallow stream channels that branch and reunite.

Meandering Stream – a stream having a pattern of successive meanders (bends, sinuous curves, loops or turns).

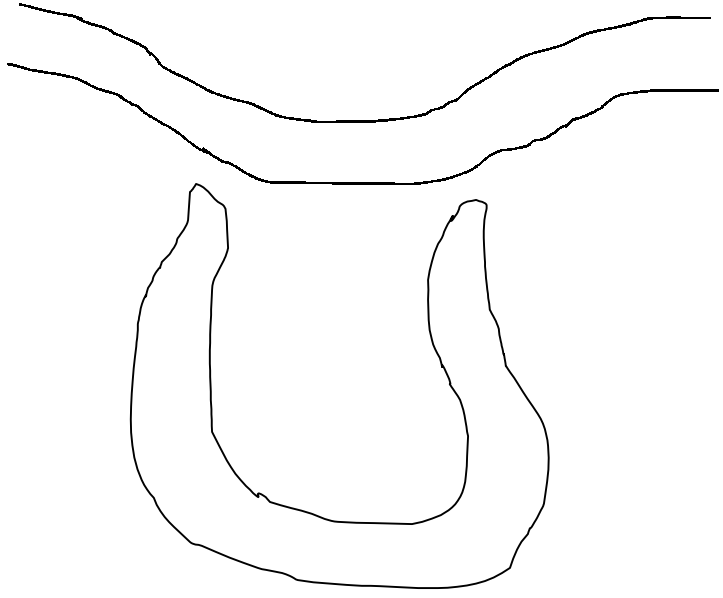
Features observed along meandering rivers
