This item request the construction of a curved granite wall as an architectural element of the landscape improvements proposed for University Drive. This wall will be a backdrop for an existing granite pedestal with an embedded Seal of the University of Houston displayed. These beautification measures are a phase of the larger campus wide Ike Recovery Landscape Improvement Project.

Project Overview

The curved wall constructed of granite will be 3'-6" high, 40'-6" in length and 1'-6" in depth. Plan and elevation are attached.

Wall design reflects the design and materials of the granite walls at Scott/Elgin, Scott/Holman, and Scott/Wheeler intersections.

Background Information:

This project is part of efforts to improve the campus landscaping and repair to repair damaged trees and plantings left by Hurricane Ike. Beautification measures include the removal and replacement of leaning trees, replacement

and improvements to landscape plantings and repair/replacement of irrigation systems to support those plantings.
