- 1. Project Name: Task Force Security Kiosks Update**

Raised security kiosks will provide an elevated platform from which security officers can observe pedestrian/vehicle movement in the lot. University of Houston Department of Public Safety personnel will staff the security kiosks from 7am until 11pm Monday through Friday.

- 2. Project Name: Blaffer Gallery Renovation**

Action: Approval of scope, location and design

The Blaffer Gallery has suffered for years from accessibility and visibility problems because it is nestled inside the Fine Arts Building. The renovation allows us to effectively tackle these challenges and improve internal circulation. The much-needed features of a street-side entrance, a café/lunch room with court yard access, ADA-compliant elevator and restroom, in combination with a new lighting system, new walls and an Art studio-gallery for the award-winning Young Artist Apprenticeship program, will significantly enhance the experience for visitors visiting the Gallery.

- 3. Project Name: University Drive Modifications**

Action: Approval of design

This item proposes the construction of a permanent access drive to parking Lot 20C from eastbound University Drive. The drive will allow entering traffic to access the lot; exiting traffic will have to utilize the existing drive further west on University Drive at the Campus Recreational and Wellness Center (CRWC). The new drive will be 16' wide, of concrete construction, and will be located approximately 250' east of the Spur 5/University Drive intersection. . An oak tree within the project site will be relocated and ADA ramps will be incorporated into the existing sidewalk on each side of the new drive.

- 4. Project Name: UC Renovation and Addition Phase II**
Presented by: Keith Kowalka and Jonathan Thurston
Action: Approval of scope and site location

At the UCU a one story addition approximately 32,000 GSF in size will be constructed over a portion of the existing “roof” (plaza). The portion of the roof not covered by new construction will be re-waterproofed and re landscaped as outdoor entertainment/community space. This UCU Addition will house all existing Student Organization program space currently located within the UCU.

The second addition will be a two story structure which will enlarge the UC by approximately 42,600 GSF. The addition’s ground level will house all food service operations; the second level will accommodate the Student Government Association Conference Chambers and a 400-seat theater/meeting space.
