**The committee reviewed and discussed the below agenda items and issued recommendations for each.**

**Approval Items**

**1. Alternate UH Energy Research Park building signage standards.**

**Presented by: Sean York**

The Office of Real Estate Services requests approval on an alternate signage standard for UHERP buildings that differs with buildings with donors. Two options will be presented.

**Committee Recommendation:** The committee recommended that chair Emily Messa review previous agenda items to understand the building signage that had previously been approved. Upon review, it was determined that building signage had previously been approved by the committee at the June 11, 2010 meeting. The chair communicated this information to Sean York, who will look at the signage holistically, partner with University Advancement on both donor and tenant signage, and return to the committee with a comprehensive building signage plan, as appropriate.

**2. Approval of historical marker for KUHT-TV Channel 8.**

**Presented by: Jim Fisher and Patricia Burd from KUHT-TV Channel 8**

Approval is requested to place an historical marker at KUHT TV in conjunction with the 60-year anniversary of the television station's first broadcast.

**Committee Recommendation:** The committee recommended the placement of the historical marker, if approved through the larger state process, at KUHT-TV and encouraged KUHT-TV to continue their work with Facilities Management to

enhance the area with landscaping features.

**3. Approval of the Informational Kiosk Site Map.**

**Presented by: Roger Warner**

Approval is requested of the design and placement of Informational Kiosks at 7 locations on campus. The kiosks are proposed to provide official locations for students and groups to post information.

**Committee Recommendation:** The committee recommended placement of outdoor information kiosks for community postings in six locations: two in the residential area (near Cougar Village and near the Quadrangle), one outside the University Center, one near the bus stop at entrance 14 (Philip Guthrie Hoffman/Agnes Arnold), and one located near the M. D. Anderson Library.

**4. Other Business:** Recent Public Art Purchase of the Luis Jimenez “Fiesta Dancers” sculpture. At a previous committee meeting, the committee reviewed the installation location for the sculpture and asked that CFPC concerns about the installation location be communicated to the System-wide Art Acquisition Committee (SWAAC).

**Recommendation:** The committee asked that the chair follow up with (SWAAC) on placement of the Luis Jimenez “Fiesta Dancers” sculpture. The committee requests SWAAC reconsider placement of this important sculpture and will communicate their concerns in writing.
