Proposal to add two at-large residential housing student representatives on the committee

Recommended Action from University Services:

The Office of University Services, UH Dining Services and Residential Life and Housing are all in support of the addition of two student reps from the residential housing community. The term will be for one year, the student must be living on campus, must go through an application process and the Food Services Advisory Committee will have the ability to vote them in as new voting members to the committee as originally stated in the proposal.

Implementation Strategy:

The positions will be added into the by-laws

Development of an application for the Residential At-Large Positions, recommended to look at the At-Large position applications

Development of a marketing strategy with current Residential Housing Association representatives for the beginning of Spring term

Implement a recommended timeline and pursue

Recommended Timeline for Implementation Strategy:

By-Laws addition by November

Development of application and marketing strategy by late November/early December, preferably by Nov. 12th

At-Large Application availability campaign starting over the Winter Break

Invite and Vote for the new members for the rest of the Spring semester by Feb. 4th
