1. On Campus Bomb Threats
  - a. Chief Moore discussed the threats of on campus bomb threats and the bomb threat at UHSL. Chief stated that the building was evacuated in 15 minutes. The Chief also discussed the HPD Summit to Outline Strategy and what they would provide for us in the event that UH Main Campus had a bomb threat. Chief Moore told the committee that we were prepared in the event of a bomb threat on campus.
2. Cell Phone Thefts
  - a. Chief discussed the fact that cell phone thefts on campus is on the rise. Chief stated that 62 cell phone thefts have occurred this year on campus. Chief stated that September (19) and October (9) had the most thefts so far this year.
  - b. The Chief discussed the fact that most phones are stolen at the Wellness Center while they were left unattended. Only 4 thefts have occurred at the Library, Chief also discussed the event that he witnessed where a student left her laptop, her backpack, cell phone at other items at a table in subway on campus while she visited the ladies room. Chief Moore spoke with the student regarding the consequences of her actions.
3. News Event
  - a. The Chief briefly spoke on the news event regarding 3 officers removed from campus due to breach of integrity. The Chief had no further comments on that subject. Chief Moore told the committee that Lot 8a or 9C wooded area will be fenced in soon.
4. Fire and Safety Update – Fire Marshall Joe Tremont
  - a. Joe Tremont told the committee that it has been approved for him to hire more personnel. Joe also told the committee that he has been appointed Interim

Environmental & Health Director. Joe also stated that he will be moving to EHS in General Services. He also stated that EHS will become a part of the Safety and Security Committee and updates will be given in the near future.

- b. Fire Marshall Tremont stated that driving by the new dining hall at night he noticed that it is extremely dark and he has a concern for the students with disabilities that may be trying to cross the streets in that area.

5. Crime Prevention Officer

The Chief stated that the new Crime Prevention Officer will be located in the library and will be placed soon.
