1. AED Program on Campus
 - a. Lieutenant Derrick McClinton discussed the AED program.
 - b. He mentioned that we offer training once an AED is ordered and before it is put in place.
 - c. CPR is now \$6.00 a person to help cover the cost of the certification card.
 - d. The CPR/AED classes can accommodate up to 20 people per class.
2. RAD Program on Campus

 - b. The class is 12 hours and can be broken down into different groupings of time.
