

Arbor Building Renovation and Addition

SUMMARY

This project entails the interior renovation and remodeling of the existing Arbor Building and additions of approximately 31,000 square feet of new space.

The building renovation will benefit the areas assigned to the School of Education by reconfiguring existing classrooms wing hallway to gain an additional classroom for early childhood education. The School of education also will benefit by a new teacher training science laboratories located in the addition.

The Fine Arts program will benefit by relocation of kilns and new facilities for the BFA program in the addition. Psychological Services program will benefit from relocating Psychological Services Clinics and Laboratories to the new addition.


The project will address the following deferred maintenance items:

- Replacement of two air handlers,
- Life safety/ADA-TAS (statutory),
- Domestic water pipes: repairs and replacement,
- Plan modifications to existing building, and
- Education wing modify hallway and math Classroom

The new addition will include space for:

- New model teaching science Classroom,
- Space for arts program aprox.
 - Wood sculpture shop
 - Relocation gas kilns.
 - Ceramic classroom/studio.
 - Faculty studios.
 - Psychological Services Clinics and Laboratories.
