Exchange program with TU Graz, Austria, and ensa-Versailles, France,

is available for a period of either **one semester** [Spring Semester] or, preferably, a **full Academic Year** [Fall and Spring Semester]

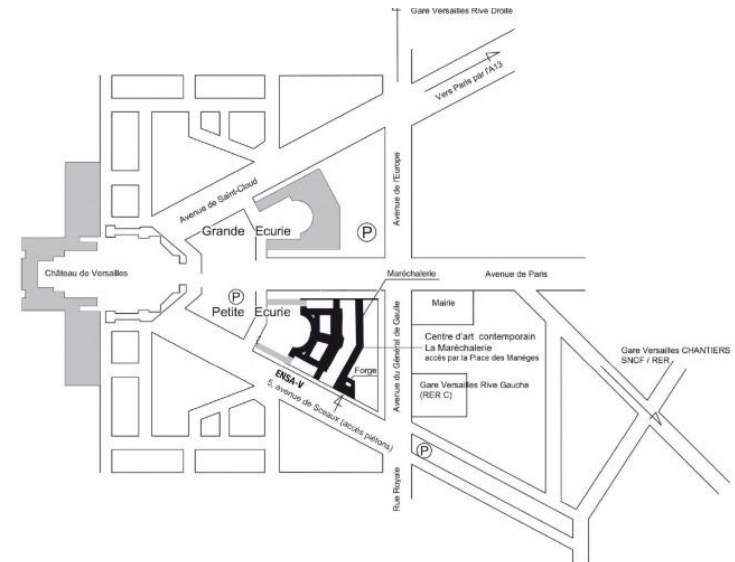
- ❑ Open for Undergraduate [ARCH 5500] and Graduate [ARCH 7600 | 7601] students
- ❑ Tuition is paid at UH
- ❑ Courses taken at the exchange institution are credited at UH
- ❑ Courses selected at the exchange institution will be reviewed for equivalency [degree plan] by CoAD
- ❑ Grades issued by the exchange institution will be recognized by the CoAD/UH

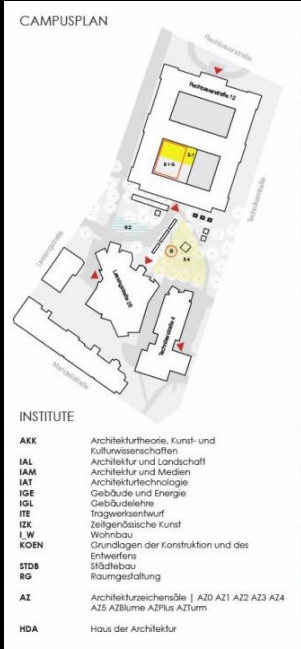
- ❑ Two students per institution and AY
- ❑ Institutions offer | require short language courses at location
- ❑ English as instructional language for studios at TU Graz, partially for ensa-V
- ❑ Health Insurance EU-wide through exchange institution

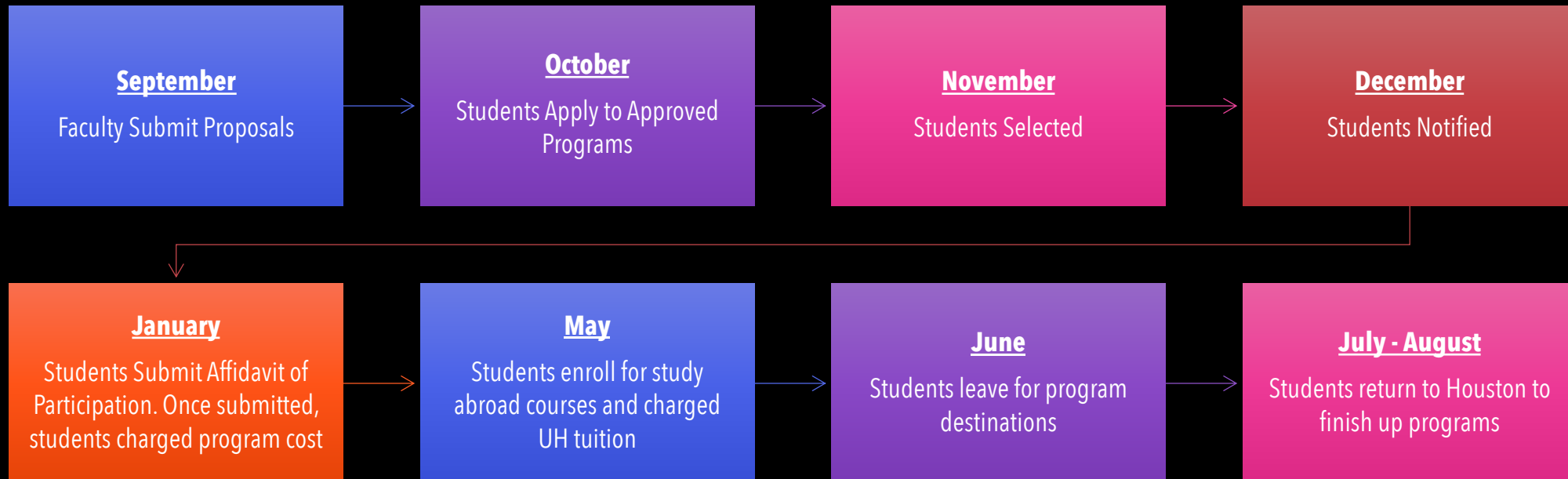

Estimated Program Costs and Financials

Program Cost	To be determined
UH Tuition	Based on University tuition rates
Airfare	Varies depending on program destination and provider
Personal spending	Varies

- UH tuition is not included in the program cost. These are separate costs that will be charged to you. Both will be charged to your UH student account.
- Students may apply for financial aid to cover study abroad costs and tuition.
- Aid is limited.
- Summer financial aid award packages may reduce fall awarding.
- Consult with the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid to confirm aid eligibility.

What should I do now to prepare?

- Make sure you have a valid and current passport
- Get vaccinated
- Check on your financial aid eligibility for summer courses
- Talk with your families about whether you can afford to study abroad
- Know your degree plan and where you stand with your classes
- Start putting a portfolio together or update it; you need it to apply
- Start contacting the references for the Study Abroad Application
- Stay tuned to the College's student listserv for the Call for Applications
