

Komora is about the orphan survivors of the 1994 Tutsi genocide in Rwanda and the people who stepped up to raise them. Emmanuel Habimana, a law student and orphan of the genocide, teams up with Natalia Ledford, an American independent filmmaker, to travel throughout Rwanda and around the world, interviewing his peers, family, heroes, and even former killers. From them they learn what survival has meant for his peers across Rwanda and what it means for them to live in a society where they must share their communities with killers.
