

Policies and Educational Impacts for Latinx Students in the United States

SPRING 2021 - MAS 3395 (ONLINE)

This course will examine the impact of United States enacted policies on Latina/o public education. The course will focus on how these policies have played an important role in history for Latinx education and how it impacts the Latinx community today.



Race and Power in the United States

SPRING 2021 - MAS 3345 (ONLINE)

This course is designed to survey and interrogate the relationship between race/ethnicity and power. By the end of the course students will have a firm understanding of the history of public policy solutions to address racial inequalities in the United States.



Mapping Latinx Stories

SPRING 2021 - MAS 3395 (ONLINE)

The course focus is on understanding the impact of the pandemic from a Latinx university student's perspective. Students will learn about the importance of oral history, its purposes, process, preservation, and best practices to record their personal experiences.
