Graduate studies in English at the University of Houston (a Tier 1 designated Research University) offers several paths to careers in writing, teaching, scholarship, criticism and related cultural professions. The combined expertise of forty-nine tenured and tenure-track professors contribute to the training of our M.A., M.F.A. and Ph.D. students whose scholarly and creative work displays talent, rigor, and interdisciplinarity. M.A. and Ph.D. Degrees in literary studies combine a focus on British, American and Anglophone literatures with new approaches in poetics, transnational and empire studies, critical race studies, translation studies, environmental studies and LGBTQ studies. Literature students may also pursue a concentration in rhetoric, composition and pedagogy, while the **Creative Writing Program** offers two additional graduate degrees which have consistently ranked in the Top 20 nationally by Poets and Writers Magazine.

The city of Houston offers a vibrant, multi-cultural setting for study at the University. Our Master's program in English has been fully redesigned to meet two goals:

1. to be relevant to the social, political, and environmental challenges of the 21st century
2. to accommodate professionals who work full- or part-time

New courses in Young Adult Latinx Literature, Literature & the Environment, and Rhetoric of Public Culture are slated for the 2022-2023 academic year. Victorian Literature emphasizes the ongoing effects of empire, while American Literature explores the context of crisis. See our **Featured Courses** page for more information.

Courses are offered during evening hours and as interactive, asynchronous online courses. Eventually, we hope to offer the option of a fully online MA degree.
