02.03 Final Student Conference and Graduation

At the end of each term, the Language and Culture Center (LCC) holds the Final Student Conference and a graduation ceremony. You are required to attend the Final Student Conference. Following the conferences, all students are encouraged to attend the graduation ceremony.

What will happen at the Final Student Conference?

- Students will receive Student Evaluations.
 - If you do not pick up your Student Evaluation, you have to wait until the third week of the following term to claim it.
- Students with zero absence will receive a Perfect Attendance Award.

What will happen at the graduation ceremony?

- Students will receive a certificate.
 - Level 6 students will receive a Certificate of Graduation if they fulfill the requirements of the certificate.
 - Students in Levels 1 through 5 will receive a Certificate of Successful Completion after the graduation ceremony if they fulfill the requirements of the certificate.
 - Under certain circumstances, students might receive a Certificate of Attendance if they fulfill the requirements of the certificate.
- Outstanding Student Award recipients will be announced.
- LCC scholarship recipients will be announced. Scholarship applicants must be present at the graduation ceremony to receive a scholarship.

I have an outstanding balance. Will I receive certificates or awards?

No. Students with an outstanding balance of any amount will not receive final student evaluations, certificates, or verification letters. Students with any outstanding balance will not be eligible to register for classes in the LCC or at the University of Houston until the balance has been cleared.
