# Curriculum

Requires 36 credit hours. Full time students typically complete the program in 4 semesters. Part time students typically complete the program in 5-6 semesters.

## **Track A – For registered dietitians or students that are currently enrolled in dietetic internships**

NUTR 6308: Clinical nutrition practice I (3 credits) Fall, Spring, Summer

NUTR 6309: Clinical nutrition practice II (3 credits) Fall, Spring, Summer

NUTR 6310: Management of nutrition and food systems practice (3 credits) Fall  
Spring Summer

# Admissions

## What are we looking for?

1. Degree in nutrition, dietetics, food science, food systems management or other health career-related subjects. If you are unsure if your degree qualifies, please email [leabbott@uh.edu](mailto:leabbott@uh.edu) with your unofficial transcripts
2. Major GPA above a 3.0 and cumulative GPA above a 3.0. Your major GPA should include your major class as well as all of your math and science classes.

# Cost

Instate Tuition & Fees Rate (9 hours per semester)  
\$4303 per semester X 4 semesters = \$17,212

Out of State Tuition & Fees (9 hours per semester)  
\$8804 per semester X4 semester = \$35,216
