Excellence in Chinese Studies Scholarship

The Chinese Studies Program will award scholarships to students who have demonstrated academic excellence in, and significant commitment to, the study of Chinese. Scholarships will be awarded to students currently enrolled in second to fourth year Chinese courses.

Eligibility requirements:

- Enrollment in the Chinese Program during the year 2011-2012.
- Although not required, preference will be given to students who have declared majors or minors in Chinese studies.
- Overall minimum GPA of 2.75.
- Overall minimum Chinese GPA of 3.25.
- Applicants should be full time students at the University of Houston.
- Application essay of good quality.

Application process:

- Submit 3 copies of the ***Excellence in Chinese Studies Scholarship*** application form.
- Submit 3 copies of the candidate's personal statement in English, stating the reasons for the application. (About 400 words).
- Submit 1 copy of a recent transcript.

NOTE: All completed applications and justifying documents must be turned in to the MCL office (613 AH) by April 10, 2012, at 5 PM.

Selection process:

The Chinese Scholarship Committee will select candidates based on academic merit, dedication to the study of the Chinese language and culture, originality of thought and purpose, and contribution to the development of the Chinese language and culture.

Advertisement of scholarships: All Chinese Program Scholarships are advertised via classroom announcement, distribution lists, bulletin boards, and university websites.
