FRENCH GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM

(2011-2012 ONLY)

Ten awards of \$400 each will be provided to undergraduate students who have received admission into the Angers Program for the academic year 2011-2012. Applicant will be selected on two criteria: merit and financial need.

Eligibility requirements:

- Applicants must be enrolled in the Angers program.
- Preference will be given to students who have declared majors or minors in French.
- Preference will be given to students who will return to UH and continue with their French studies.
- Applicants must have an overall minimum GPA of 3.00
- Applicants must be full time students at the University of Houston.

Application process:

- Submit 2 copies of a recent transcript (unofficial will be accepted).
- Submit 2 copies of the application form.
- Submit 2 copies of the candidate's one page statement in English (single space, font no smaller than 12 pts), stating the reasons for the application.
- Submit 2 copy of the degree plan in French (if available).

All completed applications and justifying documents must be turned in to the MCL office (613 AH) by **March 1, 2012, at 5 PM**. A faculty review committee will select candidates. All awardees are expected to attend the MCL Award Ceremony.

Advertisement of awards: The French Government Awards will be advertised on the MCL web site, instructors' blackboard accounts, and application forms will be sent to all study-abroad (Angers) program participants.
