FRENCH GOVERNMENT AWARDS FOR STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM

(2012-2013 academic year ONLY)

5 awards of \$500 each will be attributed to students who are committed to the study of French and French culture.

Eligibility requirements:

- Enrollment in the 2013 faculty-led Angers program.
- Enrollment in the French Program during the academic year 2012-2013.
- Preference will be given to students who have declared majors or minors in French.
- Applicants must be full time students at the University of Houston.

Application process:

- Submit a copy of your most recent transcript (unofficial will be accepted).
- Submit a copy of your degree plan in French (if available).
- Submit a one page statement in English explaining why you are applying for this award.
- All completed applications and justifying documents must be turned in to the MCL office (613 AH) by **March 1, 2013, at 5 PM.**

Candidates will be selected based on financial need, dedication to the study of the French language and culture, originality of thought and purpose. Candidates will be notified by email. Awardees are expected to attend the MCL Award Ceremony.
