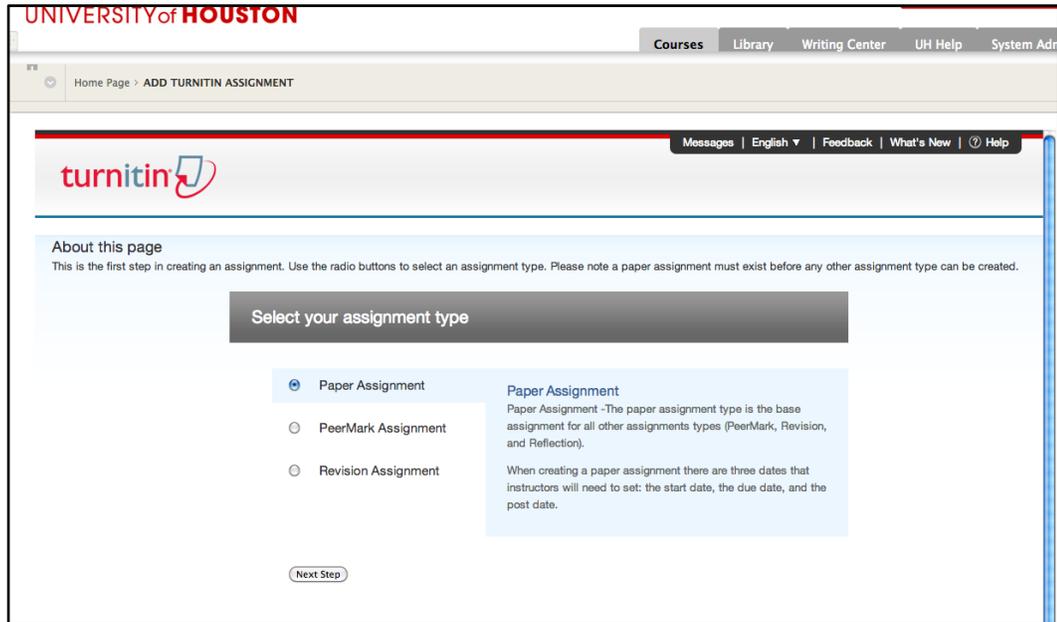


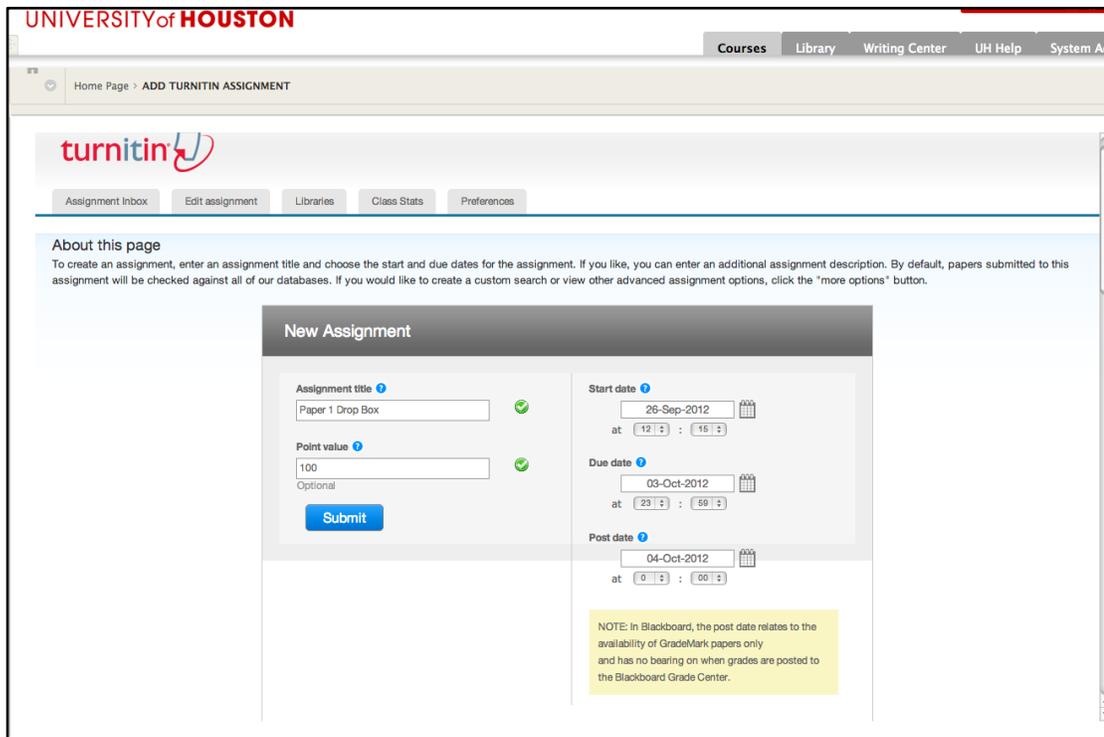
# UH Faculty Development Tutorial Turnitin Assignments

## How to create a **Turnitin Assignment Drop Box**:

- In Blackboard Learn, go to your content page with **EDIT MODE ON**
- Click on **ASSESSMENTS** on the top tool bar
- Select **Turnitin Assignment**
- You will be linked to the **Turnitin** site and will see this:
- Click on **Next Step**



- Here is where you will enter your assignment title, point value, and dates:



- **Start date** is the date that your assignment is available to students
- **Due Date** is the date that the assignment is due (you can add an option to leave the box open and accept LATE submissions that will be marked late for your review)
- **Post Date** is when the students will have access to your **Grademark** comments, if you decide to grade online
- Click on **OPTIONAL SETTINGS** and scroll down to enter any special instructions in the text box and then click on **YES** to accept late submissions

- Next you will see this screen-Click on **OK**



- Now go to your COURSE MANAGEMENT> COURSE TOOLS>Turnitin Assignments:

- Click on **ROSTER SYNC** to integrate your students with the assignment
- You can **EDIT**, Grade, and check **Similarity Reports** here:
