;SOC Electives (Advanced 6 hours)***
SOC 3400 and SOC 3401 also have required labs that must be taken at the time SOC 3400 and SOC 3401 are taken. These courses are 4 hours credit with labs.

SOC 3301 replaces SOC 3401 starting in Fall 2020. SOC 3301 does not have a required lab. SOC 3301 is 3 hours credit.

SOC 3300 and Soc 3400 should be taken during junior year and SOC 3401 or SOC 3301 should be taken senior year.

**III. ELECTIVES**: The number of hours required to bring to total number of hours to 120, of which 36 must be advanced.

The other degree requirements can be met by completion of:

- AN APPROVED MINOR
- A SECOND MAJOR
- A SECOND DEGREE
- A SENIOR HONORS THESIS

A minimum of 120 hours (including 36 advanced hours – 3000/4000 level) must be completed for this degree plan. No more than 66 hours from a Junior college can apply towards the degree. The last 30 hours must be completed uninterrupted at the University of Houston Main campus.
