


# SPAN 3305

## Spanish Grammar Review



This is an intensive Spanish grammar course with emphasis on those aspects that are problematic to second and heritage language learners.

Some of the questions we will discuss in class are:

- Why we need *grammar*?

- How do we analyze linguistic patterns?
- What is the relationship between grammar and meaning?

The course is based on sentence and discourse analysis, translation and class discussions of the different areas of Spanish grammar.
