SUMMER 2018: JUNE 25 – JULY 27**

The growing importance of the Spanish language and Hispanic culture within the US and the subsequent social necessity and demand for teachers and professionals properly trained in these areas, has led the University of Houston and the University of Salamanca to program a *Master’s Degree in Spanish Language and Hispanic Culture* with a significant part of the study time spent in Salamanca, Spain.

* At the end of the 36 required hours participants will have to take a M.A. Comprehensive Examination at the University of Houston.

CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION*: In order to be admitted into the Master’s program, prospective students must have at least one of the following:

1. BA in Spanish
2. BA in another language
3. BA in another discipline

After evaluating the undergraduate transcript of applicants whose BA is in an area other than Spanish, the Spanish Graduate Committee of the University of Houston may require them to take a number of undergraduate courses before starting the program.

COST: Students will pay the Department of Hispanic Studies at UH \$3,800 for the summer of 2018 (\$2,860 for participants who make their own housing arrangements) and \$120 to UH’s Office of Learning Abroad (OLA) Payments should be completed by May 1st.

WHAT IS INCLUDED: a) hours of class given by the University of Salamanca; b) accommodation of students in University Residences (on request, accommodation may be organized with families); c) three meals a day; c) teaching materials for the presentation of the classes; and d) medical insurance.
