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UH Transfer Rules

- Courses taken at LC must be completed with a C- or better.
- A maximum of 66 lower-level transfer credits can be used towards a UH bachelor's degree.
- A maximum of 2 credit hours in physical activity courses can transfer.

Major Requirements

- **B.S. Math:** complete 12 hours of approved mathematics courses. Students majoring in Exercise Science – Primary Option will fulfill this requirement through major coursework.
- **B.S. Natural Science:** complete 8 hours of science courses. Students majoring in Exercise Science – Primary Option will fulfill this requirement through major coursework.
- Complete KINE 1301, KIN 2304, KIN 3304, KIN 3306, KIN 3309, KIN 4310, and KIN 4370 with a C- or better.
- Students will not be core complete or earn their associate degree before transferring to UH. Students should **opt into reverse transfer when applying for admission to UH** to earn their associate degree from LC after transferring to UH.
