We will consider gender violence from a critical, intersectional, and interdisciplinary perspective, with empirical research, particularly psychological science, as a central core.

Course content will include:

- Systemic support for gender violence (review of feminist theory, exploration of contemporary politics and law)
- Manifestations of gender violence (intimate partner/domestic violence, bullying/hazing/stalking/cyber harassment, hate crimes/honor killings, etc.)
- Consequences of gender violence (stress and trauma, economy and servitude, posttraumatic growth)
- Imagining a world beyond gender violence (burning it down/activism/reform)

Course material will include both written and audiovisual media. Face-to-face class subject to change to remote as per evolving pandemic situation.
