

Isolate

If you test positive for COVID-19 or are exhibiting symptoms (e.g. fever or chills, shortness of breath, congestion) of COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status.



Symptomatic:

Stay home for 5 days.

End isolation after 5 full days* **ONLY** if:

- You are fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication
- Your other symptoms have improved

CDC recommends that you continue to wear a mask around others for an additional 5 days.

*To calculate your 5-day isolation period, day 0 is your first day of symptoms. Day 1 is the first full day after your symptoms developed.

Tested Positive & Asymptomatic:

Stay home for 5 days.

If you continue to have no symptoms, you can end isolation after 5 full days**. CDC recommends that you continue to wear a mask around others for an additional 5 days.

If you develop symptoms after testing positive, your 5-day isolation starts over. Day 0 is the first day of symptoms.

Follow the instructions on the left for Symptomatic.

**Day 0 is the day of your positive viral test (based on the date you were tested) and day 1 is the first full day after the specimen was collected for your positive test.
