he Center for Diversity and Inclusion fosters an allencompassing university community by providing services, programs and support that engage, empower and educate our highly diverse student population and campus partners. In the summer of 2013, a Multicultural Student Services Task Force was created and charged with identifying the feasibility of creating a new department/ center that would focus on addressing the needs of the University of Houston's diverse student population.

After benchmarking 22 institutions of higher education, conducting a student leader focus group and administering a campus-wide student survey, the committee recommended the department/center be created at the University of Houston. The newest department within the Division of Student Affairs and Enrollment Services, the Center opened its doors in fall 2014.

The Center for Diversity and Inclusion provides diversity education workshops and programs, a speaker series, student leadership development opportunities and program co-sponsorship. It also functions as an advocate for students and informs the community on social justice issues.

Your support will position the Center as an integral campus resource that enhances diversity, inclusion, and

students' cultural knowledge and understanding. Diversity Education, the Speaker Series and Student Leadership Development are key focus areas for the Center.
