As we return to a "post-COVID" environment, we would like to assess the academic performance of the fraternity and sorority members from Fall 2021 until current. We will monitor their overall GPA, retention rates, and graduation rates and do a deeper dive based on residential status, council, gender, race, and national level support. Our hope is to identify any trends or areas of concern and develop strategies to support academic success.

We may look at running statistical analysis on several of the variables, but depending on the data we have to work with, we may just look for trends within the data.
