Employees with both Exchange and mail.uh.edu accounts

University Information Technology (UIT) is in the process of retiring the Mail.uh.edu system. You will need to migrate your mailbox messages from the Mail.uh.edu system to the UH Exchange system. UH Exchange email accounts end with @central.uh.edu.

Please note that if you are an employee of the College of Business Administration (Exchange accounts end with @bauer.uh.edu) or the College of Optometry Administration (Exchange accounts end with @optometry.uh.edu), you should migrate your mail.uh.edu mailbox to the Exchange account you have received from within your respective colleges. All other University of Houston employees should migrate their mail.uh.edu mailbox to the Exchange account they currently hold.

Please follow the steps outlined in the UH_Mail_Retirement document to migrate from your mail.uh.edu account to your existing Exchange account. The document can be downloaded at: <http://bit.ly/SP66QR>

Please note that you must have moved your mail messages by November 15, 2012. Your Mail.uh.edu account will then be disabled.
