Dual Credit and Technical Early College High Schools

▶ Dual Credit

- Greater Pathways to Courses in
 - College Certificate Programs
 - AAS Degree Programs

▶ Technical Early College High School

- 60 College Credits
- AAS Degree
- 15 General Education Credit Core

Equity Issues

- ▶ Minimum One Endorsement Area
 - Multidisciplinary Studies
- ▶ Smaller Districts and Districts with Fewer Resources are Limited on What They Can Offer
- ▶ This is Especially True for CTE Courses
 - Facilities
 - Equipment
 - Transportation

Equity Issues continued

- ▶ Tuition Charged for College Courses Varies
- ▶ Some Districts Pay for Dual Credit, While Others Require the Student to Pay
