Equity Issues

- Minimum One Endorsement Area
 - Multidisciplinary Studies
- Smaller Districts and Districts with Fewer Resources are Limited on What They Can Offer
- This is Especially True for CTE Courses
 - Facilities
 - Equipment
 - Transportation



Equity Issues continued

- Tuition Charged for College Courses Varies
- Some Districts Pay for Dual Credit, While Others Require the Student to Pay
