# Minor in Applied Behavior Analysis

*Help others in this high-demand career.*

### PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Support the success and well-being of children and adults with autism or other disabilities with a minor in Applied Behavior Analysis. Open to all UH undergraduates, this minor is especially well-suited for aspiring teachers, psychologists, health care specialists and other helping professionals. Plus, it can open the door to a rewarding career as a Board-Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst (BCaBA).

### DURATION & FORMAT

This minor requires six courses (18 credit hours) and can be completed online.

### POSSIBLE CAREER OPTIONS

BCaBAs work in schools, hospitals, community clinics and in-home care to address clients’ behavioral challenges and enhance their quality of life. To become a BCaBA, you must complete supervised field hours and a certification exam in addition to your minor coursework. This minor also prepares graduates for careers in general and special education, counseling, speech-language pathology, physical therapy, occupational therapy and more.


### COURSE HIGHLIGHTS

Courses focus on the science of behavior, behavior assessment, intervention planning, organizational behavior management and ethical considerations.

### WHY NOW?

As the prevalence of autism spectrum disorders continues to rise, so does demand for professionals skilled in applied behavior analysis — the most successful treatment approach for children with autism. Texas is among the top five states with the highest demand for BCaBAs.
