

EDUCATION MINOR WITH TEACHER CERTIFICATION

SECONDARY EDUCATION GRADES 7-12 or EC-12: Select Content Area

This minor is intended for students who are majoring outside the College of Education and who wish to become certified to teach in the state of Texas. This minor can only be paired with specific majors. However, the minor alone does not include all coursework and experiences required to be recommended for Texas State Certification. Students who plan to complete certification at the secondary level or in select fields at all levels should select a major in the content area in which they wish to teach and complete the Education minor, with certification.

GPA Requirement:

- Must have a 2.50 minimum cumulative UH GPA to declare the minor
- Must earn a 2.50 minimum cumulative UH GPA and no lower than a C- on all courses attempted in the minor
