# Navigating the Application Process



Our Graduate Student Success Team is here to support you. Keep your ApplyWeb contact information updated and **look for email notifications.**



GSS Team starts auditing applications one month prior to the deadline to check for missing items. **Apply early** to allow more time to ensure your application is complete.



**Ph.D. programs:**  
GRE waivers are available.  
**Other programs:**  
GRE is NOT required.



Applicants may send scanned copies of official transcripts initially. Ultimately, **official transcripts** sent directly by prior institution(s) are required.



Worried about your grades? We engage in **holistic reviews** of candidate applications.

# Funding Graduate School



Complete the **FAFSA application** at [studentaid.gov](https://studentaid.gov).

- All graduate students are considered independent students.
- Typically there is a priority deadline (March).



## College/university scholarships and fellowships

- Graduate Tuition Fellowship/Presidential Fellowships for Ph.D. students
- Stella L. Ehrhardt Scholarship for M.Ed. students
- Graduate School Fund for M.Ed., Ed.D. and Ph.D. Texas residents with financial need
- UHCOE Scholarships for returning students
- University graduate assistantships (research, teaching and/or administrative)

# Funding Graduate School



## GradPLUS Loans

- Apply at [studentaid.gov](http://studentaid.gov)
- Based on creditworthiness
- Loan amount can be up to cost of attendance (minus any other financial resources)



## Private/Alternative Loans

- Student applies online with lender of their choosing
- Based on creditworthiness; may require a co-signer
- Once approved, application will be sent to college for processing






