Dear Campus Community:

The Campus-wide Access Control Project continues to upgrade building perimeter security in 2017.

As part of the Card Reader Access Control installations at most buildings, UH Lock Shop will change out all exterior door key cores to a new keying system at all buildings that have been upgraded to Card Readers. This will be an improvement to building security and provide a restart to key control. All current exterior keys will become obsolete once the new cores are installed. Key Control will request the forfeiture of all current exterior keys at the appropriate time. Once these exterior key cores are changed out, afterhours access to buildings will be exclusively by Cougar Card at your building's card reader only. New exterior keys will not be issued without authorization from the AVP for Campus Safety.

Attached is the projected schedule of key core changes across campus. Dates are subject to change. Building Coordinators will be updated on a building by building basis as work continues.
