 Report from and Discussion with the University of Houston System Chancellor and University of Houston President: Renu Khator

UH Pres. Renu Khator updated the Faculty Senate on the following items:

- Pres. Khator acknowledged the UH Men's Basketball team's successful season
 - Celebration for the basketball team: April 23, 2025, Wednesday, Fertitta Center
- ➤ SB37
 - Amendments were passed last night on the Senate committee side; The bill will go to the House Committee next, and eventually return to the Senate for vote.
 - Items listed in SB37: An In-state committee will be formed to evaluate programs/courses, ban teaching certain topics, evaluate every degree based on return on investment, TX ombudsman office to be formed, and BoR responsibilities will increase.
- SAM Hours of Work:
 - o A language gap was found in UH's policy and not consistent with Texas law.
- Immigration and visas:
 - Need to look at how UH can help students academically (i.e., complete courses online, etc.).

A Q&A session followed with focus on dealing with teaching courses and SB37 impact, dismissal of faculty, SAM – Hour of Work vs. MAPP on workload, and defending academic freedom.

3. Report from and Discussion with the University of Houston System Vice Chancellor and University of Houston Vice President for Research: Claudia Neuhauser

VP Claudia Neuhauser reported on the following items:

- > April 30, 2025, noon, Export Control & International Travel Workshop (business & personal)
- ▶ Dept. of Energy (DOE) 15% cut in IDC rate (temporary restraining order) UH is watching closely
- President's skinny budget: budget cuts in federal agencies (UH is monitoring)
- Research security training is required for faculty who have DOE grants. Other federal agencies will follow. There are four modules in the mandatory training.
- DoR Functions
 - o Looking into a ticketing system (model after the Graduate School's system)
 - o Rules and responsibilities guidelines matrix
 - Time to completion (i.e., subaward set-up): Dr. Neuhauser encouraged faculty to email her with ideas.

A brief Q&A session followed about IDC reduction rates and how to account for that funding loss.
