(Passed by majority vote of the Faculty Affairs Committee on April 25, 2007 and by majority vote of the Executive Committee on April 30, 2007)

To maintain this status and foster a supportive campus environment, the institution and its faculty are committed to supporting the rights of both individuals and groups to freely and openly express their disparate positions.
