

RESOLUTIONS ON ACADEMIC PRIORITIES

Resolution One:

Whereas funding for programs has been and will remain tight for the foreseeable future, the Faculty Senate Educational Policies and Student Affairs Committee urges any additional funds made available from the Provost's Office for enhancing the quality of programs be allocated on the basis of competitive plans submitted.

Resolution Two:

Whereas, in the past five years, faculty and staff salaries have fallen substantially behind those of comparable institutions, the Faculty Senate Educational Policies and Student Affairs Committee recommends that the Provost give high priority to this issue.

Resolution Three:

Whereas, in order for the University of Houston to remain a leader in terms of diversity, the Faculty Senate Educational Policies and Student Affairs Committee requests the amount of resources allocated to such programs should be substantial.
