

Good Neighbor Scholarship Information 2008-2009

Application

The application for the Good Neighbor Scholarship is available in Room 23 of the E. Cullen Bldg.

Application requirements

1. Copy of F-1 or J-1 visa
2. Copy of Passport
3. Copy of Admissions letter (if first time applicant)
4. Copy of I-20
5. All domestic academic transcripts
6. Resident of a Latin American country or Canada, other than Cuba or the United States.
7. Applicant must plan on returning to his/her country

Selection Process

The Assistant Director of Scholarships will rank the eligible applicants based on G.P.A, country of citizenship and priority status. The approved applications will be mailed to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) by March 15th (usually, one or two students are chosen per country).

The office of Scholarships and Financial Aid receives the award roster from the THECB approximately 2-3 weeks before the fall semester begins. If the student does not enroll by the twelfth class day of the fall semester the scholarship will be null and void. **SCHOLARSHIP COVERS TUITION ONLY.**

Student Responsibilities

1. Must enroll for at least 12 hours (UG) or 9 hours (GR) at the University of Houston.
2. Must maintain good academic standing (2.0 or above).
3. Must reapply every year for the Good Neighbor Scholarship.
4. Good Neighbor Scholarship (waiver) exempts student from tuition only
