

DID YOU KNOW?

Even though the 2024–25 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form is shorter and easier to fill out than the previous version, high school seniors in the Houston area are behind on FAFSA submissions. There are three tips to help students complete their form listed below!

2024-25 FAFSA TIPS

- 1. Know what a contributor is.** A “contributor” refers to anyone who provides information on an applicant’s form.
- 2. Help students create an FSA ID.** Students and contributors must have an FSA ID to complete the form.
- 3. Encourage applying early.** Due to changes to the application, the 2024-25 FAFSA form opened in December 2023 instead of Oct. 1. Because of additional delays, colleges will not receive the FAFSA information until April. The sooner students file, the better the chances for more federal aid.
