

PROVOST COMPLETION GRANT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Office of the Provost established the Provost Completion Grant (PCG) Program to facilitate timely graduation by providing financial assistance to students who are close to graduating but who have financial need that is impeding degree completion. Grant awards are subject to availability of funds. Eligibility requirements include financial need, good academic standing, and being on track to graduate within two semesters.
