

## Texas Funding Eligibility Form

Effective May 23, 2022, all institutions are required to confirm eligibility as it relates to child support arrearages.

*Instructions:* If you are a state aid recipient, complete this form including a signature and today's date. No funds will be released until you have submitted this form to the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid and your eligibility has been confirmed. Please note that your offered state-funded financial aid may have additional requirements you must also meet prior to disbursement.

Pursuant to the [Texas Family Code, Title 5, Section 231.006](#), a student who is obligated to pay child support and is more than 30 days delinquent is not eligible to receive state-funded financial aid, including the TEXAS Grant and College Access Loan. To comply with this requirement all students receiving state-funded financial aid must answer the question below before state aid can be disbursed.
