DOCTORAL DEGREE

The Ph.D. program is a multi-conceptual and research-based program that cultivates top quality hospitality and tourism educators and researchers. The average time to complete this degree is three years.

Ph.D. in Hospitality Administration

- 60-credit, on-campus program designed for those who wish to pursue career opportunities in universities, research institutions, and industry throughout the world
- Develop skills to teach and conduct scholarly research at the university level
- Dissertation

FUNDING SUPPORT

Doctoral students receive financial support through a graduate assistantship, which provides a tuition waiver for up to nine credits, partial fee waiver, and a monthly stipend. Doctoral students also receive funds for conference travel, dissertation research, and a summer research experience.

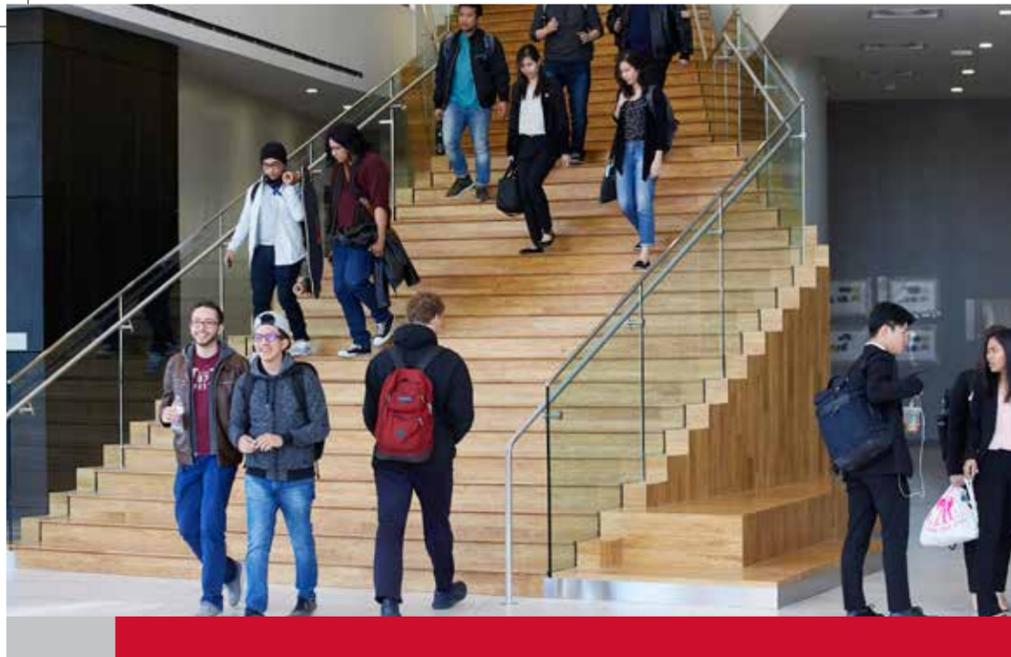

ONLINE DEGREE

The Executive Master of Hospitality Administration is a self-paced, online degree for professionals in the hospitality industry who hold at least three years of management experience in the hospitality industry. Courses run in eight-week sessions (two sessions in Fall and Spring terms and one in Summer term).

Master of Hospitality Administration

- 30-credit, online only program designed for mid-level professionals seeking to advance in the hospitality industry
- Develop knowledge in the latest management and leadership techniques with a hospitality or gaming management focus
