COUGAR MOVE-IN

IMPORTANT UPDATES

- January 11 - January 15, 2021
 - Residents must sign up for individual time slots via their myHousing portal
 - Residents, their families, and all guests will be asked to follow social distancing protocols

MOVE-IN SIGN UP PROCESS

1. Log into myHousing Portal
2. Select a Move-in date and time
3. Accept the COVID-19 acknowledgements

Move-in sign up tips:

- Only sign up for one time slot
- Please adhere to your move-in date and time
- You can change your sign up time as many times as you need to until January 11



This year's Cougar Move-In will look a little different than the past. Due to COVID-19, Student Housing & Residential Life has implemented new guidelines designed to support social distancing. Cougar Move-In will take place from January 11 - 15, 2021.

Mandatory Requirements for Move-In:

- Face coverings will be required for students and any guests assisting with moving in.
- In order to adhere to strict sanitation protocols, there will be a limited number of carts available at the residence halls for students to use during the move-in process. **We encourage you to bring your own moving supplies.**
- Residents will only be able to have a maximum of two (2) guests to assist them while moving in. Due to the safety of our staff, we will not have volunteers available to assist with unloading vehicles.
- Be sure to follow social distancing protocols, including maintaining a six feet distance from others
- If you or anyone attending move in with you are feeling sick or displaying the symptoms of COVID-19, you may not come to campus and will need to reschedule your move-in time. Please follow the UH COVID-19 FAQ for guidelines on reporting illness.

Please continue to check your myHousing portal and our website for all Move-In updates.

Move-In Date & Time Selection

It is important that you adhere to your move-in day and time. If you need to change your selected day and time, you may do so until January 11th by returning to your myHousing portal.

SHRL COVID-19 UPDATE +

All high touch areas are disinfected a minimum of two times daily.

SHRL COVID-19 operating levels listed on our website.

- Guests are only allowed within the common areas.

Residents are required to wear face coverings within the common areas of our residence halls.

- Signage is posted around halls and reminders are sent to residents through email, social media, and at desks

There are designated quarantine & isolation spaces on campus

- COVID-19 testing is available for students at the UH Student Health Center.



SHRL COVID-19 UPDATE +

Returning from International Travel

Students returning from international travel are required to complete one of the following upon return to the United States:

- Self-quarantine for 14 days OR
- Get tested 3-5 days after travel AND stay home for 7 days after travel.
 - Even if you test negative, stay home for the full 7 days.
 - If your test is positive, stay home and follow the COVID-19 Diagnosis protocols.

Check with your roommates/suitemates to avoid bringing duplicate items.


PACK YOUR THINGS IN BOXES & TOTES

Label all of your items with your name, building name, and room number.

GET AN EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS KIT

Each kit should contain supplies for a 72-hour period and include medicine, food, and important documents.

WHAT TO EXPECT ON MOVE-IN DAY

Find the Community Flag for Your Building

1. Once you arrive, pull into an unloading parking spot
2. You will be greeted by a SHRL staff member
3. Start unloading your vehicle
4. Visit the lobby to receive your welcome gift & keys
5. Move your items into your space
6. Move your car to the permanent parking zone
7. Walk back to your residential hall



MOVE-IN REMINDERS

- **Bring your own cleaning and moving supplies**
- **Arrive in only one vehicle**
- **No more than 2 guests per student**
- **There will be a limited number of carts**
- **Adhere to social distancing guidelines**
- **Face mask/coverings are required at all times**
- **If you feel sick, please stay home and reschedule your move-in date and time**



IMPORTANT HOUSING DEADLINE

Deadline to cancel your spring-only housing agreement without penalty:

December 15

Students who currently live on campus may cancel their agreements at any time but are subject to penalties as detailed in the residence halls service agreement.
