



## The CougarVision Television Network, available on your computer!

IPTV is a service designed to provide video programming over the University of Houston data network. IPTV offers local, national and University of Houston's own, Student Video Network.

IPTV is only available on campus in Cougar Village at the present time. Availability will be expanded to cover other areas at a future time. To launch the player, go to [cougarvision.e.uh.edu](http://cougarvision.e.uh.edu), and click on the red CV InSTREAM button.

Please note that IPTV is only available from campus locations. If the player does not launch after a few seconds, scroll down and use the "It Didn't Work" button and we'll contact you soon to address your issue. When prompted, please select "TRUST" to allow the player to launch.

It may take a few seconds for the player to launch.

**To Activate the channel double-click on the channel name. Then click "Watch TV" in the upper right hand corner.**

**For player controls right click on the player screen. (Mac users Control-Click)**
