**Over-the-Counter Medications**

Please check all items that CAT Camp staff may give your camper if they should need medication while at camp:

- Acetaminophen (*Tylenol* or other non-aspirin pain reliever)
- Ibuprofen (*Motrin, Advil*)
- Throat lozenges
- Antihistamine (*Benadryl*)
- Calamine, Caladryl or other anti-itch lotion
- Antibiotic ointment (*Neosporin*)
- Hydrocortisone cream
- Antacid (*Tums*)
