Traditional BSN Track Application to Change Course of Study to Nursing Major

Students are eligible to apply to the CON Traditional BSN Track once they have completed or are enrolled to complete 60 semester credit hours (SCH) of course requirements for nursing, of which 45 SCH must be in residence at UH.

1. Have you completed or are enrolled to complete 45 semester credit hours in residence at the University of Houston? Completed is defined as: courses finished, and final grades are reflected on your UH transcript. Enrolled is defined as: courses listed in progress on your transcript this semester.
 - NO.** If no, you are not eligible to apply to nursing as your major. Once you have completed or are enrolled to complete 45 semester credit hours reflected in your UH transcript, you may apply.
 - YES,** I have completed or I am enrolled to complete 45 SCH at UH.
2. Will you complete 60 SCH of course requirements for nursing before the fall semester for which you are applying? (Please fill out: Course Requirement Checklist)
 - NO.** If no, you are not eligible to apply to nursing as your major. You must complete all course requirements for nursing before applying to the major.
 - YES,** I will have completed 60 SCH of course requirements for nursing before the fall semester for which I am applying.
