

**POLICY TITLE: AUDIO/VIDEO RECORDING AND PHOTOGRAPHING**

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**Policy**

Students must receive prior permission of the person(s) presenting class information before photographing, audio and/or recording or videoing formal presentations or informal discussions.

Taping, video recording, or photographing in clinical settings is **ABSOLUTELY NOT PERMITTED** under any circumstance.

Photographing, videotaping, filming, digitally recording, or by any other means, secretly viewing with or without a device, another person without that person's consent in any location where the person has a reasonable expectation of privacy, or in a manner that violates a reasonable expectation of privacy will be considered a breach in professional conduct.

Breaches in professional conduct will be sanctioned and may result in clinical failure, course failure and/or dismissal from the nursing program.
