POLICY TITLE: LICENSURE ELIGIBILITY

Policy

After graduation, students who do not meet the requirements for initial licensure in the state of Texas will not receive an “endorsement form”.

Candidates for the licensure examination after graduation that do not meet the requirements for initial licensure are **not eligible for licensure** in the State of Texas. The Texas Board of Nursing (BON) may refuse to approve persons to take the licensure examination, may refuse to issue or renew a license or certificate of registration, or may refuse to issue a temporary permit to any individual that has been convicted of or received a deferred disposition for a felony, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude, or engaged in conduct resulting in the revocation of probation. (Texas Board of Nursing, Rule 213.30)
