Board rule 17.12(c) (3) requires Committee approval to purchase real property having a total appraised value of \$10 million up to \$25 million. 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Tuition Revenue Bonds Projects	Board rule 17.12(b) (5) authorizes the Assistant Commissioner to approve projects funded with more than 50 percent Tuition Revenue Bonds that meet Board standards and having a total project cost less than \$25 million.	Board rule 17.12(a) (5) authorizes the Commissioner to approve projects funded with more than 50 percent Tuition Revenue Bonds that meet Board standards and having a total project cost of \$25 million or more.	Board rule 17.12(c) (5) requires Committee approval of projects funded with more than 50% tuition revenue bond proceeds and not qualifying for Commissioner approval. Auxiliary Enterprise Projects	Board Rule 17.12 (b) (6) authorizes the Assistant Commissioner approve projects being acquired, constructed, or renovated w/o the use of state general revenue funds & with a total project less than \$15 million.	Board rule 17.12(a)(6) authorizes the Commissioner to approve projects being acquired, constructed, or renovated w/o the use of state general revenue funds & with a total project cost of \$15 million up to \$25 million.	Board rule 17.12(c) (6) requires Committee approval for Auxiliary Enterprise projects having a total project cost of \$25 million up to \$50 million. System Projects	Board rule 17.12(b) (9) authorizes the Assistant Commissioner to approve any new construction, major repair and renovation, or property acquisition that affects only the University System and not a member institution, and has a total project cost less than \$15 million.	Board rule 17.12(a)(9) authorizes the Commissioner to approve new construction, major repair and renovation, or property acquisition that affects only the University System and not a member institution, and has a total projected cost of \$15 million up to \$25 million.	Board rule 17.12 (c) (8) requires Committee approval on new construction, major repair and renovation, or property acquisition submitted by a University System that only affects the system with a total projected cost of \$25 million or more.	Board rule 17.12(d) (5) requires Board approval for any projects referred to the Board by the Committee or Commissioner.
Project Referrals		Board rule 17.12(a) (11) authorizes the Commissioner to approve any project referred by the Assistant Commissioner. Board rule 17.12(d) (5) requires Board approval for any projects referred by the Committee or Commissioner.

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Previously Approved Projects	<p>Board rule 17.12(b) (7) authorizes the Assistant Commissioner to approve previously Assistant Commissioner approved projects, providing they continue to be eligible for Assistant Commissioner level approval.</p> <p>Board rule 17.12(b)(8) authorizes the Assistant Commissioner to approve projects previously reviewed or approved by the Board, Committee, or Assistant Commissioner that require reconsideration relating to <u>any change in the funding source of an approved project</u> with a total cost less than \$25 million.</p>	<p>Board rule 17.12(a) (7) authorizes the Commissioner to approve projects previously reviewed or approved by the Commissioner but requiring first or second reconsideration, providing they continue to be eligible for Commissioner approval.</p> <p>Board rule 17.12(a) (8) authorizes the Commissioner to approve projects previously reviewed or approved by the Board, Committee, or Commissioner that require reconsideration relating to <u>any change in the funding source of an approved project</u> with a total cost of \$25 million or more.</p>	<p>Board rule 17.12(c) (7) requires Committee approval for projects requiring re-approval that are not eligible for Commissioner re-approval.</p> <p>Board rule 17.12(c) (11) requires Committee approval for projects requiring a third re-approval.</p>	<p>Board rule 17.12(d) (5) requires Board approval for any projects referred to the Board by the Committee or Commissioner.</p>
Emergency Requests	<p>A project would be eligible to submit a request for Emergency Approval if: (1) delaying the project would result in an unacceptable cost to the state; or (2) the project is necessary because of a natural disaster; or (3) there is an unavoidable circumstance whereby the delay would critically impair the institution's mission. EXEMPT from Coordinating Board Approval:

- Less than 10% change in project costs for previously approved projects.
- Less than 10% change in gross square feet for previously approved projects.
- New construction costing less than \$4 million*.
- Major repair and renovation costing less than \$4 million*.
- Gifts or lease-purchase of **unimproved** real property.
- Lease of Property or Facility.
- Projects for The University of Texas Austin, Texas A&M University, and Prairie View A&M University financed with more than 50% Permanent University Funds or Available University Funds.
- Gifts, grants, or lease-purchase arrangements intended for **clinical or research facilities**.
- New construction or major repair and renovation projects specifically approved by the legislature.
