PURPOSE OF THE SURVEY

The survey is being conducted in compliance with the Center's mission "to collect, analyze, and disseminate statistics and other information related to education in the United States...," (P.L. 103–382, National Education Statistics Act of 1994, Sec.

USES OF DATA

Survey results will be used in a variety of ways. For example, they will be used, together with other data, to idescribe the condition of postsecondary education in the nation. The information will be summarized by various institutional categories to detect any changes over the years in the sources of revenues and types of expenditures. Results will allow institutions to compare their financial data to national averages. The data will also be marged with other institutional data, such as enrollment and completions, to provide a valuable national resource for institutional research.

Changes from the FY 1998 form for FY 1999 FINANCE SURVEY
